R E S O L U T I O N

1        WHEREAS, Memories of a life filled with joyful times and  
2 meaningful accomplishments remain to comfort the family and friends  
3 of William Albert Swinney Sr., who passed away on April 20, 2023, at  
4 the age of 99; and

5        WHEREAS, The son of James R. Swinney and Bessie Garner  
6 Swinney, Bill Swinney was born in Rogers on July 8, 1923, and grew  
7 up with a younger brother, Robert, and sister, Garnett; during the  
8 Great Depression, the family moved frequently between ranches and  
9 small towns in Central Texas and Mississippi, and as the oldest  
10 child, Mr. Swinney took on enormous responsibility; nevertheless,  
11 he graduated as president of his high school class; during World  
12 War II, he enlisted in the U.S. Army Air Corps as soon as he was of  
13 age, and he served as a waist gunner on a B-24 Liberator bomber in  
14 the Pacific Theater; he went on to attend the University of  
15 Mississippi and studied law in Texas before embarking on an  
16 entrepreneurial path; after decades as a general contractor, he  
17 focused on land development and real estate; not a believer in  
18 retirement, he worked as long as he was able; and

19       WHEREAS, In 1948, he married the former Marjorie June  
20 Gustafson, and they were blessed with six children; he encouraged  
21 them to share his enthusiasm for fitness by creating an extensive  
22 backyard playground on the family's seven-acre lot in San Antonio;  
23 the family also enjoyed water sports at their vacation house on Lake  
24 LBJ; on April 14, 1990, Mr. Swinney wed Brenda Kennedy, who

1 inspired him to read his Bible and become active in church again; in  
2 addition, they supported scholarships for students at a Christian  
3 school near their home; together, they adopted his  
4 great-grandchild, Scarlett; Mr. Swinney loved to hear his wife play  
5 hymns and marches on the piano and organ; an inspiration to others,  
6 the couple was profiled in the April 2023 edition of the Billy  
7 Graham Evangelistic Association's *Decision Magazine*; and

8 WHEREAS, Although Bill Swinney is deeply missed, he leaves  
9 behind a legacy of devotion to his family, his faith, and his  
10 country that his loved ones can remember with pride; now,  
11 therefore, be it
