A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

2 relating to the use of recycled glass in aggregate used by the Texas
3 Department of Transportation.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Subchapter I, Chapter 201, Transportation Code,
6 is amended by adding Section 201.712 to read as follows:

7 Sec. 201.712. REQUIREMENTS FOR AGGREGATE IN HIGHWAY
8 IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS. (a) In this section, "glass cullet" means
9 recycled, crushed glass suitable as a replacement for gravel
10 aggregate in roadway construction.

11 (b) Each year the department shall use, or enter into a
12 contract to use, at least 10,000 cubic yards per year of glass
13 cullet gathered in this state as a replacement for aggregate
14 material.

15 SECTION 2. Section 201.712, Transportation Code, as added
16 by this Act, applies only to a year that begins on or after January
17 1, 2010.

18 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
