**IN RE: HB4407** by Taylor (Relating to maintaining a supply of anaphylaxis medicine on public school campuses served by school nurses.), **As Introduced**

<b>No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.</b>

This bill would require the Commissioner of Education to adopt rules establishing the amount of anaphylaxis medicine maintained at a school campus. The Texas Education Agency estimates that this cost would be absorbed within existing resources.

**Local Government Impact**

Costs for school districts, in implementing the bill's requirement to maintain a supply of anaphylaxis medicine at each campus with a school nurse, could vary but are not expected to be significant on a statewide basis.
