C. S. H. B. No. 384

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

2 relating to the proper identification of boats and outboard motors;
3 creating an offense.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Section 31.033, Parks and Wildlife Code, is
6 amended by adding Subsection (c) to read as follows:

7 (c) No person may display on a vessel a registration decal
8 that is altered, fraudulent, or issued under a certificate of
9 number assigned to another vessel.

10 SECTION 2. Section 31.043, Parks and Wildlife Code, is
11 amended by adding Subsection (c-1) to read as follows:

12 (c-1) No person may intentionally sell, offer to sell, or
13 purchase a vessel with a hull identification number, or an outboard
14 motor with a serial number, that has been altered, defaced,
15 mutilated, or removed.

16 SECTION 3. Section 31.127(b), Parks and Wildlife Code, is
17 amended to read as follows:

18 (b) A person who violates Section 31.043(c) or 31.096 [or
19 ~~this code~~] commits an offense that is a Class B Parks and Wildlife
20 Code misdemeanor. A person who violates Section 31.043(c-1)
21 commits an offense that is a Class A Parks and Wildlife Code
22 misdemeanor.

23 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
24 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as

1 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
2 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
3 Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
