R E S O L U T I O N

1 WHEREAS, Words cannot express the sorrow felt at the loss of
2 Texas Department of Public Safety trooper Jonathan Thomas McDonald
3 of Post, who died in the line of duty on November 15, 2010, at the
4 age of 28; and

5 WHEREAS, Jonathan McDonald was born in Lubbock on July 24,
6 1982, to Cindy and John McDonald; he graduated from Greenwood High
7 School in 2000 and earned a bachelor's degree in business
8 administration and marketing from Texas Tech University in 2005;
9 and

10 WHEREAS, Mr. McDonald married his high school sweetheart, the
11 former Laura Michelle Thornton, in 2006, and together they were
12 blessed with a daughter, Kacyn, who was born in 2010; and

13 WHEREAS, While attending college, Mr. McDonald worked for
14 United Supermarkets, eventually attaining the position of manager;
15 in 2008, he felt called to public service and took a reduction in
16 salary to join the Texas Department of Public Safety; he graduated
17 from the DPS Academy in September of that year and was subsequently
18 stationed in Post; and

19 WHEREAS, At the time of his death, Trooper McDonald had
20 worked in the community for two years, during which time he had won
21 the respect and affection of residents and colleagues alike; a man
22 of strong faith, he was an active member of the First Baptist Church
23 in Post; and

24 WHEREAS, Although he was taken much too soon, Jonathan
