**IN RE: HB684** by Larson (relating to housing prisoners in a tent or other facility in lieu of a county jail.), **Committee Report 1st House, Substituted**

**No fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.**

The bill would amend the Local Government Code to allow a county to house an inmate in a tent or other facility other than a county jail for the duration of the sentence. Current statute permits housing an inmate in such facilities at the request of a sheriff and the commissioners court of a county with the authorization of the Commission on Jail Standards. The bill would require the Commission on Jail Standards to adopt rules to govern the facilities.

**Local Government Impact**

No significant fiscal implication to units of local government is anticipated.
