S.B. No. 670

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

# 1 AN ACT

2 relating to the copying of certain records and files relating to a  
3 child who is a party to a juvenile proceeding.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Subsection (b), Section 58.007, Family Code, is  
6 amended to read as follows:

12 (1) the judge, probation officers, and professional  
13 staff or consultants of the juvenile court;

14 (2) a juvenile justice agency as that term is defined  
15 by Section 58.101;

16 (3) an attorney for a party to the proceeding;

17 (4) a public or private agency or institution  
18 providing supervision of the child by arrangement of the juvenile  
19 court, or having custody of the child under juvenile court order; or

20 (5) with leave of the juvenile court, any other  
21 person, agency, or institution having a legitimate interest in the  
22 proceeding or in the work of the court.

23 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives  
24 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as

1 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this  
2 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this  
3 Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
