**IN RE: SB810** by Seliger (Relating to the authority of an independent school district to contract with a municipality for the design, improvement, or construction of an instructional facility, stadium, or other athletic facility.), **As Introduced**

**No fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.**

The bill would allow a school district to enter into a written agreement with the municipality in which it is located to contribute resources to pay a portion of the costs of the design, improvement, or construction of certain facilities owned by, on the property of, or under the control of the municipality.

**Local Government Impact**

No significant fiscal implication to units of local government is anticipated. Any administrative costs related to these provisions would be voluntary for the participating school district.

There may be a positive fiscal impact to municipalities; however impact will vary depending on the amount of resources contributed by a school district.
