H.B. No. 2293

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

2 relating to the certification by the comptroller to the
3 commissioner of education of the taxable value of property in each
4 school district.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

6 SECTION 1. Section 403.302(j), Government Code, is amended
7 to read as follows:

8 (j) The [For purposes of Chapter 42, Education Code, the]
9 comptroller shall certify the final taxable value for each school
10 district, appropriately adjusted to give effect to certain
11 provisions of the Education Code related to school funding, to the
12 commissioner of education as provided by the terms of a memorandum
13 of understanding entered into between the comptroller and the
14 commissioner of education[+]

15 [(1) a final value for each school district computed
16 on a residence homestead exemption under Section 1-b(c), Article
17 VIII, Texas Constitution, of \$5,000.

6 SECTION 2. Section [403.302\(k\)](#), Government Code, is
7 repealed.

8 SECTION 3. The change in law made by this Act applies only
9 to a certification made by the comptroller of public accounts of the
10 adjusted taxable value for a school district to the commissioner of
11 education on or after the effective date of this Act.

12 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect January 1, 2016.
