S.B. No. 2184

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

2 relating to the required age for a license or permit relating to the
3 conduct of a public fireworks display.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Section 2154.101(b), Occupations Code, is
6 amended to read as follows:

(b) A person who is younger than 18 [21] years of age may not be issued a [pyrotechnic operator's license. The minimum age of a person issued another] license under Subchapter D [is 18 years of age].

11 SECTION 2. Section 2154.201(a), Occupations Code, is
12 amended to read as follows:

13 (a) [A person who is younger than 21 years of age may not be
14 issued a public fireworks display permit.] A person who is younger
15 than 18 years of age may not be issued a [another] permit under this
16 subchapter.

17 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
