S.B. No. 3065

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

2 relating to the creation of the Wolf Creek Municipal Management
3 District No. 1; providing authority to issue bonds; providing
4 authority to impose assessments, fees, and taxes; granting a
5 limited power of eminent domain.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

7 SECTION 1. Subtitle C, Title 4, Special District Local Laws
8 Code, is amended by adding Chapter 4015 to read as follows:

CHAPTER 4015. WOLF CREEK MUNICIPAL MANAGEMENT DISTRICT NO. 1

SUBCHAPTER A. GENERAL PROVISIONS

Sec. 4015.0101. DEFINITIONS. In this chapter:

(1) "Board" means the district's board of directors.

(2) "City" means the City of Greenville.

(3) "County" means Hunt County.

(4) "Director" means a board member.

(5) "District" means the Wolf Creek Municipal District No. 1.

Sec. 4015.0102. NA

ipal Management District No. 1 is a special district created

20 under Section 59, Article XVI, Texas Constitution.

21 Sec. 4013.0103. PURPOSE; DECLARATION OF INTENT. (a) The
22 creation of the district is essential to accomplish the purposes of
23 Sections 52 and 52-a, Article III, and Section 59, Article XVI,
24 Texas Constitution, and other public purposes stated in this

1 chapter.

2 (b) By creating the district and in authorizing the county,
3 the city, and other political subdivisions to contract with the
4 district, the legislature has established a program to accomplish
5 the public purposes set out in Section 52-a, Article III, Texas
6 Constitution.

7 (c) The creation of the district is necessary to promote,
8 develop, encourage, and maintain employment, commerce,
9 transportation, housing, tourism, recreation, the arts,
10 entertainment, economic development, safety, and the public
11 welfare in the district.

12 (d) This chapter and the creation of the district may not be
13 interpreted to relieve the county or the city from providing the
14 level of services provided as of the effective date of the Act
15 enacting this chapter to the area in the district. The district is
16 created to supplement and not to supplant county or city services
17 provided in the district.

18 Sec. 4015.0104. FINDINGS OF BENEFIT AND PUBLIC PURPOSE.
19 (a) All land and other property included in the district will
20 benefit from the improvements and services to be provided by the
21 district under powers conferred by Sections 52 and 52-a, Article
22 III, and Section 59, Article XVI, Texas Constitution, and other
23 powers granted under this chapter.

24 (b) The district is created to serve a public use and
25 benefit.

26 (c) The creation of the district is in the public interest
27 and is essential to further the public purposes of:

1 (1) developing and diversifying the economy of the
2 state;
3 (2) eliminating unemployment and underemployment; and
4 (3) developing or expanding transportation and
5 commerce.

6 (d) The district will:

7 (1) promote the health, safety, and general welfare of
8 residents, employers, potential employees, employees, visitors,
9 and consumers in the district, and of the public;

10 (2) provide needed funding for the district to
11 preserve, maintain, and enhance the economic health and vitality of
12 the district territory as a community and business center;

13 (3) promote the health, safety, welfare, and enjoyment
14 of the public by providing pedestrian ways and by landscaping and
15 developing certain areas in the district, which are necessary for
16 the restoration, preservation, and enhancement of scenic beauty;
17 and

18 (4) provide for water, wastewater, drainage, road, and
19 recreational facilities for the district.

20 (e) Pedestrian ways along or across a street, whether at
21 grade or above or below the surface, and street lighting, street
22 landscaping, parking, and street art objects are parts of and
23 necessary components of a street and are considered to be a street
24 or road improvement.

25 (f) The district will not act as the agent or
26 instrumentality of any private interest even though the district
27 will benefit many private interests as well as the public.

1 Sec. 4015.0105. INITIAL DISTRICT TERRITORY. (a) The
2 district is initially composed of the territory described by
3 Section 2 of the Act enacting this chapter.

4 (b) The boundaries and field notes contained in Section 2 of
5 the Act enacting this chapter form a closure. A mistake in the
6 field notes or in copying the field notes in the legislative process
7 does not affect the district's:

8 (1) organization, existence, or validity;
9 (2) right to issue any type of bonds for the purposes
10 for which the district is created or to pay the principal of and
11 interest on the bonds;
12 (3) right to impose or collect an assessment or tax; or
13 (4) legality or operation.

14 Sec. 4015.0106. ELIGIBILITY FOR INCLUSION IN SPECIAL ZONES.
15 All or any part of the area of the district is eligible to be
16 included in:

17 (1) a tax increment reinvestment zone created under
18 Chapter 311, Tax Code; or
19 (2) a tax abatement reinvestment zone created under
20 Chapter 312, Tax Code.

21 Sec. 4015.0107. APPLICABILITY OF MUNICIPAL MANAGEMENT
22 DISTRICTS LAW. Except as otherwise provided by this chapter,
23 Chapter 375, Local Government Code, applies to the district.

24 Sec. 4015.0108. CONSTRUCTION OF CHAPTER. This chapter
25 shall be liberally construed in conformity with the findings and
26 purposes stated in this chapter.

SUBCHAPTER B. BOARD OF DIRECTORS

2 Sec. 4015.0201. GOVERNING BODY; TERMS. (a) The district is
3 governed by a board of five elected directors who serve staggered
4 terms of four years.

5 (b) Directors are elected in the manner provided by
6 Subchapter D, Chapter 49, Water Code.

7 Sec. 4015.0202. COMPENSATION; EXPENSES. (a) The district
8 may compensate each director in an amount not to exceed \$150 for
9 each board meeting. The total amount of compensation for each
10 director in one year may not exceed \$7,200.

11 (b) A director is entitled to reimbursement for necessary
12 and reasonable expenses incurred in carrying out the duties and
13 responsibilities of the board.

14 (c) Sections 375.069 and 375.070, Local Government Code, do
15 not apply to the board.

16 Sec. 4015.0203. TEMPORARY DIRECTORS. (a) On or after the
17 effective date of the Act creating this chapter, the owner or owners
18 of a majority of the assessed value of the real property in the
19 district according to the most recent certified tax appraisal roll
20 for the county may submit a petition to the Texas Commission on
21 Environmental Quality requesting that the commission appoint as
22 temporary directors the five persons named in the petition. The
23 commission shall appoint as temporary directors the five persons
24 named in the petition.

25 (b) The temporary or successor temporary directors shall
26 hold an election to elect five permanent directors as provided by
27 Section 4015.0201.

1 (c) Temporary directors serve until the earlier of:

2 (1) the date permanent directors are elected under

3 Subsection (b); or

4 (2) the fourth anniversary of the effective date of

5 the Act creating this chapter.

6 (d) If permanent directors have not been elected under

7 Subsection (b) and the terms of the temporary directors have

8 expired, successor temporary directors shall be appointed or

9 reappointed as provided by Subsection (e) to serve terms that

10 expire on the earlier of:

11 (1) the date permanent directors are elected under

12 Subsection (b); or

13 (2) the fourth anniversary of the date of the

14 appointment or reappointment.

15 (e) If Subsection (d) applies, the owner or owners of a

16 majority of the assessed value of the real property in the district

17 according to the most recent certified tax appraisal roll for the

18 county may submit a petition to the Texas Commission on

19 Environmental Quality requesting that the commission appoint as

20 successor temporary directors the five persons named in the

21 petition. The commission shall appoint as successor temporary

22 directors the five persons named in the petition.

23 SUBCHAPTER C. POWERS AND DUTIES

24 Sec. 4015.0301. GENERAL POWERS AND DUTIES. The district

25 has the powers and duties necessary to accomplish the purposes for

26 which the district is created.

27 Sec. 4015.0302. IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS AND SERVICES. (a) The

1 district, using any money available to the district for the
2 purpose, may provide, design, construct, acquire, improve,
3 relocate, operate, maintain, or finance an improvement project or
4 service authorized under this chapter or Chapter 375, Local
5 Government Code.

6 (b) The district may contract with a governmental or private
7 entity to carry out an action under Subsection (a).

8 (c) The implementation of a district project or service is a
9 governmental function or service for the purposes of Chapter 791,
10 Government Code.

11 Sec. 4015.0303. NONPROFIT CORPORATION. (a) The board by
12 resolution may authorize the creation of a nonprofit corporation to
13 assist and act for the district in implementing a project or
14 providing a service authorized by this chapter.

15 (b) The nonprofit corporation:

16 (1) has each power of and is considered to be a local
17 government corporation created under Subchapter D, Chapter 431,
18 Transportation Code; and

19 (2) may implement any project and provide any service
20 authorized by this chapter.

21 (c) The board shall appoint the board of directors of the
22 nonprofit corporation. The board of directors of the nonprofit
23 corporation shall serve in the same manner as the board of directors
24 of a local government corporation created under Subchapter D,
25 Chapter 431, Transportation Code, except that a board member is not
26 required to reside in the district.

27 Sec. 4015.0304. LAW ENFORCEMENT SERVICES. To protect the

1 public interest, the district may contract with a qualified party,
2 including the county or the city, to provide law enforcement
3 services in the district for a fee.

4 Sec. 4015.0305. MEMBERSHIP IN CHARITABLE ORGANIZATIONS.

5 The district may join and pay dues to a charitable or nonprofit
6 organization that performs a service or provides an activity
7 consistent with the furtherance of a district purpose.

8 Sec. 4015.0306. ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT PROGRAMS. (a) The

9 district may engage in activities that accomplish the economic
10 development purposes of the district.

11 (b) The district may establish and provide for the
12 administration of one or more programs to promote state or local
13 economic development and to stimulate business and commercial
14 activity in the district, including programs to:

15 (1) make loans and grants of public money; and
16 (2) provide district personnel and services.

17 (c) The district may create economic development programs
18 and exercise the economic development powers provided to
19 municipalities by:

20 (1) Chapter 380, Local Government Code; and
21 (2) Subchapter A, Chapter 1509, Government Code.

22 Sec. 4015.0307. PARKING FACILITIES. (a) The district may

23 acquire, lease as lessor or lessee, construct, develop, own,
24 operate, and maintain parking facilities or a system of parking
25 facilities, including lots, garages, parking terminals, or other
26 structures or accommodations for parking motor vehicles off the
27 streets and related appurtenances.

1 (b) The district's parking facilities serve the public
2 purposes of the district and are owned, used, and held for a public
3 purpose even if leased or operated by a private entity for a term of
4 years.

5 (c) The district's parking facilities are parts of and
6 necessary components of a street and are considered to be a street
7 or road improvement.

8 (d) The development and operation of the district's parking
9 facilities may be considered an economic development program.

10 Sec. 4015.0308. DISBURSEMENTS AND TRANSFERS OF MONEY. The
11 board by resolution shall establish the number of directors'
12 signatures and the procedure required for a disbursement or
13 transfer of district money.

14 Sec. 4015.0309. ADDING OR EXCLUDING LAND. Except as
15 provided by Section 4015.0310, the district may add or exclude land
16 in the manner provided by Subchapter J, Chapter 49, Water Code, or
17 by Subchapter H, Chapter 54, Water Code.

18 Sec. 4015.0310. DIVISION OF DISTRICT. (a) The district may
19 be divided into two or more new districts only if the district:

20 (1) has no outstanding bonded debt; and
21 (2) is not imposing ad valorem taxes.

22 (b) This chapter applies to any new district created by the
23 division of the district, and a new district has all the powers and
24 duties of the district.

25 (c) Any new district created by the division of the district
26 may not, at the time the new district is created, contain any land
27 outside the area described by Section 2 of the Act enacting this

1 chapter.

2 (d) The board, on its own motion or on receipt of a petition
3 signed by the owner or owners of a majority of the assessed value of
4 the real property in the district, may adopt an order dividing the
5 district.

6 (e) An order dividing the district must:

7 (1) name each new district;

19 Sec. 4015.0311. EMINENT DOMAIN. The district may exercise
20 the power of eminent domain in the manner provided by Section
21 49.222, Water Code.

SUBCHAPTER D. ASSESSMENTS

23 Sec. 4015.0401. PETITION REQUIRED FOR FINANCING SERVICES

24 AND IMPROVEMENTS WITH ASSESSMENTS. (a) The board may not finance a

25 service or improvement project with assessments under this chapter

26 unless a written petition requesting that service or improvement

27 has been filed with the board.

1 (b) A petition filed under Subsection (a) must be signed by
2 the owners of a majority of the assessed value of real property in
3 the district subject to assessment according to the most recent
4 certified tax appraisal roll for the county.

5 Sec. 4015.0402. ASSESSMENTS; LIENS FOR ASSESSMENTS. (a)
6 The board by resolution may impose and collect an assessment for any
7 purpose authorized by this chapter in all or any part of the
8 district.

9 (b) An assessment, a reassessment, or an assessment
10 resulting from an addition to or correction of the assessment roll
11 by the district, penalties and interest on an assessment or
12 reassessment, an expense of collection, and reasonable attorney's
13 fees incurred by the district:

14 (1) are a first and prior lien against the property
15 assessed;

16 (2) are superior to any other lien or claim other than
17 a lien or claim for county, school district, or municipal ad valorem
18 taxes; and

19 (3) are the personal liability of and a charge against
20 the owners of the property even if the owners are not named in the
21 assessment proceedings.

22 (c) The lien is effective from the date of the board's
23 resolution imposing the assessment until the date the assessment is
24 paid. The board may enforce the lien in the same manner that the
25 board may enforce an ad valorem tax lien against real property.

26 (d) The board may make a correction to or deletion from the
27 assessment roll that does not increase the amount of assessment of

1 any parcel of land without providing notice and holding a hearing in
2 the manner required for additional assessments.

3 SUBCHAPTER E. TAXES AND BONDS

4 Sec. 4015.0501. TAX ELECTION REQUIRED. (a) The district
5 must hold an election in the manner provided by Chapter 49, Water
6 Code, or, if applicable, Chapter 375, Local Government Code, to
7 obtain voter approval before the district may impose an ad valorem
8 tax.

9 (b) Section 375.243, Local Government Code, does not apply
10 to the district.

11 Sec. 4015.0502. OPERATION AND MAINTENANCE TAX. (a) If
12 authorized by a majority of the district voters voting at an
13 election under Section 4015.0501, the district may impose an
14 operation and maintenance tax on taxable property in the district
15 in the manner provided by Section 49.107, Water Code, for any
16 district purpose, including to:

- 17 (1) maintain and operate the district;
- 18 (2) construct or acquire improvements; or
- 19 (3) provide a service.

20 (b) The board shall determine the operation and maintenance
21 tax rate. The rate may not exceed the rate approved at the
22 election.

23 Sec. 4015.0503. AUTHORITY TO BORROW MONEY AND TO ISSUE
24 BONDS AND OTHER OBLIGATIONS. (a) The district may borrow money on
25 terms determined by the board.

26 (b) The district may issue, by public or private sale,
27 bonds, notes, or other obligations payable wholly or partly from ad

1 valorem taxes, assessments, impact fees, revenue, contract
2 payments, grants, or other district money, or any combination of
3 those sources of money, to pay for any authorized district purpose.

4 (c) The district may issue, by public or private sale,
5 bonds, notes, or other obligations payable wholly or partly from
6 assessments in the manner provided by Subchapter A, Chapter 372,
7 Local Government Code, if the improvement financed by the
8 obligation issued under this section will be conveyed to or
9 operated and maintained by a municipality, county, or other retail
10 utility provider pursuant to an agreement with the district entered
11 into before the issuance of the obligation.

12 Sec. 4015.0504. BONDS SECURED BY REVENUE OR CONTRACT
13 PAYMENTS. The district may issue, without an election, bonds
14 secured by:

15 (1) revenue other than ad valorem taxes, including
16 contract revenues; or
17 (2) contract payments, provided that the requirements
18 of Section 49.108, Water Code, have been met.

19 Sec. 4015.0505. BONDS SECURED BY AD VALOREM TAXES;
20 ELECTIONS. (a) If authorized at an election under Section
21 4015.0501, the district may issue bonds payable from ad valorem
22 taxes.

23 (b) At the time the district issues bonds payable wholly or
24 partly from ad valorem taxes, the board shall provide for the annual
25 imposition of a continuing direct annual ad valorem tax, without
26 limit as to rate or amount, for each year that all or part of the
27 bonds are outstanding as required and in the manner provided by

1 Sections 54.601 and 54.602, Water Code.

2 (c) All or any part of any facilities or improvements that
3 may be acquired by a district by the issuance of its bonds may be
4 submitted as a single proposition or as several propositions to be
5 voted on at the election.

6 SUBCHAPTER I. DISSOLUTION

7 Sec. 4015.0901. DISSOLUTION. (a) The board shall dissolve
8 the district on written petition filed with the board by the owners
9 of:

10 (1) at least two-thirds of the assessed value of the
11 property subject to assessment by the district based on the most
12 recent certified county property tax rolls; or

13 (2) at least two-thirds of the surface area of the
14 district, excluding roads, streets, highways, utility
15 rights-of-way, other public areas, and other property exempt from
16 assessment by the district according to the most recent certified
17 county property tax rolls.

18 (b) The board by majority vote may dissolve the district at
19 any time.

20 (c) The district may not be dissolved by its board under
21 Subsection (a) or (b) if the district:

22 (1) has any outstanding bonded indebtedness until that
23 bonded indebtedness has been repaid or defeased in accordance with
24 the order or resolution authorizing the issuance of the bonds;

25 (2) has a contractual obligation to pay money until
26 that obligation has been fully paid in accordance with the
27 contract; or

1 (3) owns, operates, or maintains public works,
2 facilities, or improvements unless the district contracts with
3 another person for the ownership, operation, or maintenance of the
4 public works, facilities, or improvements.

5 (d) Sections 375.261, 375.262, and 375.264, Local
6 Government Code, do not apply to the district.

7 SECTION 2. The Wolf Creek Municipal Management District
8 No. 1 initially includes all territory contained in the following
9 area:

6 amended by adding Section 4015.0311 to read as follows:

7 Sec. 4015.0311. NO EMINENT DOMAIN POWER. The district may
8 not exercise the power of eminent domain.

9 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
10 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
11 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
12 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
13 Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
