A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

# 1 AN ACT

2 relating to the designation of a portion of State Highway 164 in  
3 Limestone County as the State Trooper Chad M. Walker Memorial  
4 Highway.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

6 SECTION 1. Section 225.190, Transportation Code, as added  
7 by Chapter 927 (H.B. 3512), Acts of the 87th Legislature, Regular  
8 Session, 2021, is redesignated as Section 225.214, Transportation  
9 Code, and amended to read as follows:

10 Sec. 225.214 [225.190]. TROOPER CHAD M. WALKER MEMORIAL  
11 HIGHWAY. (a) The portion of State Highway 164 in Limestone County  
12 between the western municipal limits of Groesbeck [~~its intersection~~  
13 ~~with Farm-to-Market Road 1953~~] and the bridge over the Navasota  
14 River [~~its intersection with County Road 789~~] is designated as the  
15 Trooper Chad M. Walker Memorial Highway. The designation is in  
16 addition to any other designation.

17 (b) Subject to Section 225.021(c), the department shall:

18 (1) design and construct markers indicating the  
19 designation as the Trooper Chad M. Walker Memorial Highway and any  
20 other appropriate information; and

21 (2) erect a marker at each end of the highway and at  
22 appropriate intermediate sites along the highway.

23 SECTION 2. To the extent of any conflict, this Act prevails  
24 over another Act of the 88th Legislature, Regular Session, 2023,
