S.B. No. 242

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

relating to the identification of and prohibited cooperation by state and local entities with certain federal acts that violate the United States Constitution.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

SECTION 1. Title 7, Government Code, is amended by adding Chapter 794 to read as follows:

CHAPTER 794. IDENTIFICATION OF AND PROHIBITED COOPERATION WITH CERTAIN UNCONSTITUTIONAL ACTS OF FEDERAL GOVERNMENT

Sec. 794.001. DEFINITIONS. In this chapter:

(1) "Political subdivision" has the meaning assigned by Section [791.003](#).

(2) "State agency" has the meaning assigned by Section [751.001](#).

Sec. 794.002. REVIEW OF EXECUTIVE ORDERS. (a) On the last day of each month, the attorney general shall provide a written report to the governor, lieutenant governor, speaker of the house of representatives, and each member of the legislature that:

(1) identifies each rule adopted by a federal government agency during the previous month that:

(A) relates to:

(i) pandemics or other health emergencies;

(ii) the regulation of natural resources, including coal and oil;

2 industry;

3 (iv) the use of land;

4 (v) the regulation of the financial sector
5 as it relates to environmental, social, or governance standards;

6 (vi) the regulation of the constitutional
7 right to keep and bear arms;

8 (vii) the free exercise of religion,
9 including the congregating of religious practitioners; or

10 (viii) border security;

11 (B) was adopted in response to an executive order
12 by the president of the United States; and

13 (C) violates the rights guaranteed to the
14 citizens of the United States by the United States Constitution;
15 and

16 (2) provides the status of any lawsuit filed against
17 the federal government relating to a rule identified by any report
18 prepared under this section, including whether a court has found
19 the rule to violate the rights guaranteed to the citizens of the
20 United States by the United States Constitution.

21 (b) The attorney general shall publish any report prepared
22 under this section on the attorney general's Internet website and
23 in the Texas Register.

24 Sec. 794.003. COOPERATION WITH UNCONSTITUTIONAL ACTS.
25 Notwithstanding any other law, a state agency or political
26 subdivision may not cooperate with a federal government agency in
27 implementing an agency rule that a report published under Section

1 794.002 indicates has been found by a court to violate the rights
2 guaranteed to the citizens of the United States by the United States
3 Constitution.

4 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
5 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
6 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
7 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
8 Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
