

R E S O L U T I O N

1 WHEREAS, Dr. Maria-Elena Giner has been named the 2023 Señora
2 Internacional by the League of United Latin American Citizens
3 Council No. 12 in Laredo; and

4 WHEREAS, Each year, LULAC Council No. 12 selects a Señor and
5 Señora Internacional as part of the Washington's Birthday
6 Celebration in Laredo, a month-long event that features parades, a
7 carnival, and an international bridge ceremony symbolizing the
8 friendship between the U.S. and Mexico; chosen for their
9 contributions to Hispanic Americans and the Southwest, the honorees
10 each represent one side of the U.S.-Mexico border; and

11 WHEREAS, The daughter of an immigrant, Maria-Elena Giner grew
12 up along the U.S.-Mexico border, and she is both bicultural and
13 bilingual; she attended Loretto Academy in El Paso and continued
14 her education at Loyola Marymount University, where she earned a
15 bachelor's degree in civil engineering; she went on to receive a
16 master's degree in business administration from The University of
17 Texas at El Paso and a doctorate in public policy from UT Austin;

19 WHEREAS, Dr. Giner previously served as the general manager
20 for the Border Environment Cooperation Commission, and over the
21 course of her tenure, she focused on policies addressing
22 U.S.-Mexico cooperation on water, energy, and climate change; in
23 2021, she was appointed to her current role as the U.S. commissioner
24 of the International Boundary and Water Commission, United States

1 and Mexico; a registered professional engineer, she has also
2 published extensively on water policy and transboundary bilateral
3 cooperation; and

4 WHEREAS, Maria-Elena Giner has made vital contributions to
5 the U.S.-Mexico border region, and she is indeed deserving of this
6 most recent honor; now, therefore, be it

7 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 88th Texas
8 Legislature hereby congratulate Dr. Maria-Elena Giner on being
9 named the 2023 Señora Internacional by LULAC Council No. 12 in
10 Laredo and extend to her sincere best wishes for continued success
11 with her important work; and, be it further
