1        WHEREAS, Memories of a life filled with joyful times and  
2 meaningful accomplishments remain to comfort the family and friends  
3 of George Herman McGowan of Houston, who passed away on April 2,  
4 2023, at the age of 93; and

5        WHEREAS, The son of Samuel O. McGowan Sr. and Berniece  
6 Ninian, George McGowan was born in Houston on October 18, 1929, and  
7 he grew up in the Fifth Ward; he was a student at Phillis Wheatley  
8 High School in 1945, when he joined the U.S. Army and served for  
9 four months during World War II; he subsequently returned to  
10 Wheatley High, graduating with honors in 1947 and going on to attend  
11 Texas Southern University; in 1952, he rejoined the U.S. Army,  
12 served during the Korean War, and attained the rank of master  
13 sergeant; he concluded his service as a member of the U.S. Air Force  
14 Reserve; and

15       WHEREAS, Mr. McGowan enjoyed a 33-year career with the U.S.  
16 Postal Service as a mail carrier; he was also a real estate  
17 developer, and he played an important role in the construction of 17  
18 Fifth Ward properties and in the renovation of his church, Payne  
19 Chapel AME; he was honored with the mayoral proclamation of George  
20 Herman McGowan Day in Houston in February 2022; and

21       WHEREAS, Mr. McGowan shared 55 years with his wife, Theresa,  
22 until her death in 2006; he was the devoted father of five children,  
23 Anthony, Theresa, Herman, Karen, and Nina, and he took tremendous  
24 pride in his many grandchildren; in his 90s, he garnered thousands

1 of fans as sidekick "Paw Paw" to his grandson, Chef Kolby Kash, on  
2 social media, offering entertaining commentary about their  
3 culinary creations; and

4 WHEREAS, Deeply dedicated to his family, his faith, and his  
5 community, George McGowan earned the lasting admiration and  
6 affection of all who were privileged to know him; now, therefore, be
